Following are the minutes of the meeting of the Board of Park Commissioners.

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Meadows Pavilion (max 100 People)

Fees suggested by Park Board:

Residents	Half Day \$ 80	Full Day \$150
Non Residents	Half Day \$120	Full Day \$220

Hours:

Half Days 8AM-1PM and 2PM-7PM Full Day 8AM-7PM

There will be a Village employee to check in/out applicant at the beginning and end of each reservation.

Damage Deposit:

\$250 damage deposit will be kept for every application

Garbage:

Must remove own garbage (Carry in/Carry out)

Alcohol Use:

The Village Board of Trustees has approved the use of alcohol in the pavilion area only if a permit is obtained from the Scotia Police Department.

Park Board discussion on alcohol-

J. Figliola and D. VanPatten are strongly against allowing any alcohol for many reasons including that they feel the Village would still be liable if any law suit should be filed, also they feel it is too close to the Little League area and puts an undue burden on the Scotia Police department.

The Park board suggests the alcohol permit should allow beer and wine only, no glass containers.

Sign must be put up stating alcohol is not allowed beyond a certain point as to not permit it to be brought in other areas of the park especially if walking to the bathrooms at the Little League area.

If an alcohol permit is approved from the Scotia Police department, an officer would need to be at the pavilion at the start and during the event to make sure that rules are being followed.

As discussed, all alcohol applications will go through the police department, but should be indicated on our application if applying.

Other Suggestions to include on Pavilion rental application:

Limits to bands and stereo equipment

Leash law is in effect

If Pavilion is not rented, groups of people over certain # will not be allowed to be there without a permit.

The person who applied for the pavilion rental must be at the event for the duration.

Preferred reservation dates will be January 1 – February 29 for village residents only. First come first served after that date.
