

Mayor Kastberg called the meeting to order at 6:00p.m.

PRESENT: Trustee Gifford, Mathes, Rizzo and Mayor Kastberg

EXCUSED: Trustee Lockwood

PROPERTY MAINTENANCE PROPOSAL

The Mayor proposed hiring a part-time employee for property maintenance. This employee would cite, follow up and schedule maintenance of properties that are not maintained in areas such as grass, brush, snow and rubbish. The funding of the employee would be covered by the \$200 administration fee charged for each property maintenance the Village does. The board supported the proposal; the Mayor will continue to work on the details.

DISCUSSION OF OVERNIGHT PARKING RESTRICTION

The current parking restriction on all Village streets is from 3:00a.m. to 6:00a.m. on both sides of the street. Trustee Mathes proposed allowing alternate side overnight parking.

The Mayor outlined the following reasons that the current parking restriction is in place:

1. Allows optimal passage for large emergency vehicles and plows, especially on our narrower streets.
2. Facilitates snow removal.
3. Limits the number of legal and illegal rental properties to those who have ample off street parking.
4. Eliminates long term parking of boats, RVs, trailers. These fall under the same law as cars.
5. Provides our police with a window of observation over the whole village.
6. Avoids a congested look opposite the small village atmosphere we wish to promote.

The board agreed to keep the current overnight parking restriction law.

UPDATES FROM MAYOR

The Mayor and Superintendent Kohout met with the steering committee from the Town of Glenville regarding the joint wastewater treatment plant. MacDonald Engineering will revise the original study to adjust the estimated flows for the Town in future years and the cost to Glenville residents living in the sewer districts. Once the revised study is complete both board will meet together to review.

The Mayor proposed amending the Village of Scotia Fee Schedule for reservation of the Freedom Park Stage; \$50/residents and \$100/non-residents. This will be on the agenda for the regular board meeting.

The Mayor and department heads will be meeting with Bob Murray of Shelter Planning to discuss grant opportunities for the Village.
