

Mayor Kastberg called the meeting to order at 6:00p.m.

PRESENTATION BY TOWN OF GLENVILLE SUPERVISOR REGARDING PROPOSED DUTCH MEADOWS FACILITIES

Supervisor Koetzle stated that a Planned Unit Development consisting of multi-family, single-family and commercial properties is proposed for Dutch Meadows Lane. The developer has offered to donate a 6 acre site as a possible site for a Joint Municipal Center. This offer is in concept only; there are no proposals or details on the project. Koetzle stated that the Town of Glenville needs to know the Village of Scotia's position regarding this proposal in order to move forward. Mayor Kastberg distributed a map of the potential site; which would need to be annexed into the Village in order for Village offices to be there.

Mayor Kastberg stated that costs would have to be calculated to determine if there would be a savings and then a decision would need to be made if the savings is worth moving services outside of the main downtown area. The Mayor stated that the Village Facilities committee has been charged with looking into all options for a municipal building. The committee will be meeting on Thursday, October 18th; once they have a recommendation, it will be presented to the Village Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees will then determine the best way to move forward on the project.
