HUMANA MEDICARE HEALTH PLAN

Joe Mancini presented an overview of the current Medicare Plans and the proposal for Humana Medicare Plan effective January 1, 2021. The Village currently offers CDPHP Medicare Choice Plan for Medicare eligible retirees that reside in 26 counties in New York State. Blue Shield Medicare Plan is offered to those retirees outside of the CDPHP coverage area. Joe Mancini of Marshall and Sterling provided the board with an overview of a Humana Medicare Plan which would allow all retirees to have the same coverage regardless of location.

PUBLIC INFORMATION OFFICER

The Mayor stated that the Police Department and Fire Department each have a Public Information Officer. The board discussed a unified voice for all departments. Trustee Cook stated that he met with Elite Venture regarding changing the template of the current website; suggested that the Public Information Officer would also be responsible for updates to the website. The board will continue discussion on this issue.
