

Proposed Local Law Number 2021-E

A local law to amend the Code of the Village of Scotia, New York relating to Outdoor Maintenance of Property regarding Outdoor Furniture

Be it enacted as by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Scotia a new local law as follows:

Section 1. Village Code New Chapter entitled “Outdoor Maintenance of Property” is added as follows:

1. Prohibited Furniture.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, either as owner, occupant, lessee, agent, tenant, or otherwise to use or place upholstered furniture, not manufactured for outdoor use, including upholstered chairs, upholstered couches and mattresses, in any yard, driveway, roof, unenclosed porch or other exposed area.

2. Enforcement.

This chapter shall be enforced by the Building Inspector.

3. Penalties for offenses.

Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this article shall, upon conviction thereof, be punishable by a fine of not more than \$250 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 15 days, or both.

Section 2. This local law shall become effective immediately.
