APPLICATION AND PERMIT FOR USE OF VILLAGE NON-PARKLAND PROPERTY FOR SHENENDEHOWA ROWING

Nancy Paulsen of Shenendehowa Rowing (dba Friends of Shenendehowa Crew, Inc.) provided the board of an overview of an Application and Permit of Use of Village Non-Parkland Property. The property requested for use is the five-acre parcel between the Village of Scotia pump station, including the boat launch ramp, extending to the Serth property downriver, and including the bike path between the river and solar farm.

Application made for 1 year with 3-5 events to be held per year; a map was provided to show the proposed layout for the events. Based on recommendations by Attorney Marola, the board discussed the following: Revised map to be submitted using only land where permission has been received by other property owners.

Path for trailers; there are concrete barriers and the bike path is not suitable for vehicles.

Parking plan for participants to be submitted perhaps directing people to park in beach parking lot or Beukeendaal if permission received.

Event participants that submit an application with hold harmless to Shenendehowa Rowing should include language for hold harmless be added for Village.

Permit would be contingent upon:

Providing required permits from Canal Cor/DEC if any

Providing Insurance Certificate with Village named as additional insured.

Be it Resolved that the Non-Parkland Property Use Application as submitted by Shenendehowa Rowing and as amended by approved for use through November 30, 2021 contingent upon providing the Village with required insurance and any required permits.
