

VILLAGE OF SCOTIA REFERENDUM

Held Tuesday, JUNE 7, 2022

Proposition offered for voting: Shall the bond resolutions adopted by the Village of Scotia, New York on May 11, 2022 authorizing (1) the undertaking by the Village of the project (the “Project”) described as follows: (a) the renovation of the current Village Hall/Fire Station located at 4 N. Ten Broeck Street in the Village of Scotia into a Village Hall Facility, which shall include the Clerk’s Office, Police Department, Building Inspector’s Office, Village Court, Mayor and Board of Trustees Office and meeting/conference space; and (b) the construction on a parcel of land located at 138 Mohawk Avenue in the Village of Scotia of a new fire safety facility, including necessary site work and the acquisition and installation of furnishings, fixtures, equipment, machinery and apparatus for the foregoing purposes, and (2) the financing of the Project by the issuance of serial bonds, and bond anticipation notes in anticipation of such bonds, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$13,800,000, be approved?
