Whereas, the Village of Scotia is the recipient of American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) funds as a Non-Entitlement Unit of Local Government, and

Whereas, a wide variety uses of ARPA funds by local governments are allowed, now therefore,

Be It Resolved that the Board of Trustees approves use of ARPA funds for the following:

\$75,000.00 for a new fire department utility vehicle plus outfitting and further authorizes the purchase of a 2022 Ford Super Duty F-350 SRW fire department utility vehicle from Orleans Ford in the amount of \$63,091.00.
