Representative Jeremy Sagaille, owner and project manager was in attendance to present the site plan and application for the property located at 13 Bancker Avenue. The applicant wishes to renovate the existing building into a 9-unit apartment building. The property lies partially in the Village of Scotia and partially in the Town of Glenville. Proposed renovations include: Painting and repairing sidings, landscaping, repairing and replacing decking, sidewalks around building, rear stairway, dumpster pad with enclosure. The parking lot, which is in the Town of Glenville side will also undergo renovations and will be expanded by approximately 20'. Snow will be moved and stored on site. The landscaping on the property shall be maintained. The Planning Board has no concerns with the application.
