**RESOLUTION TO INCREASE THE SALARY OF THE CLERK-TREASURER**

Whereas, the work of the Village Clerk-Treasurer has continued to increase, grow more complex and become more demanding, and

Whereas, it is in the interest of the Village to remain competitive for the position, now therefore

**VILLAGE PRIORITIES**

Mayor suggested settling on a structure for the fireworks event related to public safety, funding, vendor permits and volunteers. The board discussed adopting a Fundraising Plan, meeting with department heads to determine needs including assessment of how operating plan worked last year and outreach for volunteers. Board will further discuss at the December 13<sup>th</sup> meeting.
