

Collins Lake Water Quality Improvement
SEQRA NEGATIVE DECLARATION

A resolution in connection with the Village of Scotia determination of non-significance pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) regulations 6NYCRR Part 617.

WHEREAS, the Village of Scotia has determined that it needs to continue to treat Collins Lake with an herbicide in order to target treat the invasive Water Chestnut; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Scotia has reviewed treatment options with Ready Scout, LLC and has determined the use of the herbicide, Sculpin G will selectively control the target invasive plant allowing desirable native species to remain for fish habitat, bottom cover and oxygen production; and,

WHEREAS, as part of the environmental review of the project, the Village of Scotia Village Board has accepted Lead Agency status and has conducted a coordinated review of this unlisted action in compliance with regulations required under the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA); and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Scotia Village Board as lead agency has completed a final detailed review of the Part 2 of the SEAF, and has made a determination that this unlisted action will not have a significant environmental impact;

Resolved, that the Mayor of the Village of Scotia, acting as responsible officer of the Village of Scotia Village Board is hereby authorized to make a negative declaration and to complete and sign the Determination of Significance on the SEQR Full Environmental Assessment Form indicating that the project will not have a significant adverse effect on the environment.
