FREEDOM PARK CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Freedom Park Foundation representatives Cathy Gatta and Louise Gundrum provided the board with an overview of the Capital Campaign for 2026 in recognition of the 50th Anniversary of Freedom Park. The project would include renovations of backstage area, new storage rooms, façade improvements, ADA compliant pathways from one end of the amphitheater to the other, ADA compliant pathways to public restrooms, and permanent placement of sound equipment. Project costs are estimated at \$998,800; a project interest form has been submitted for NY Forward Grant.

Attorney Marola will provide guidance on procurement procedures relating to Freedom Park Foundation and the Village of Scotia.
